They were taught prayers and tying different sort of knots and also learnt how to make tents.



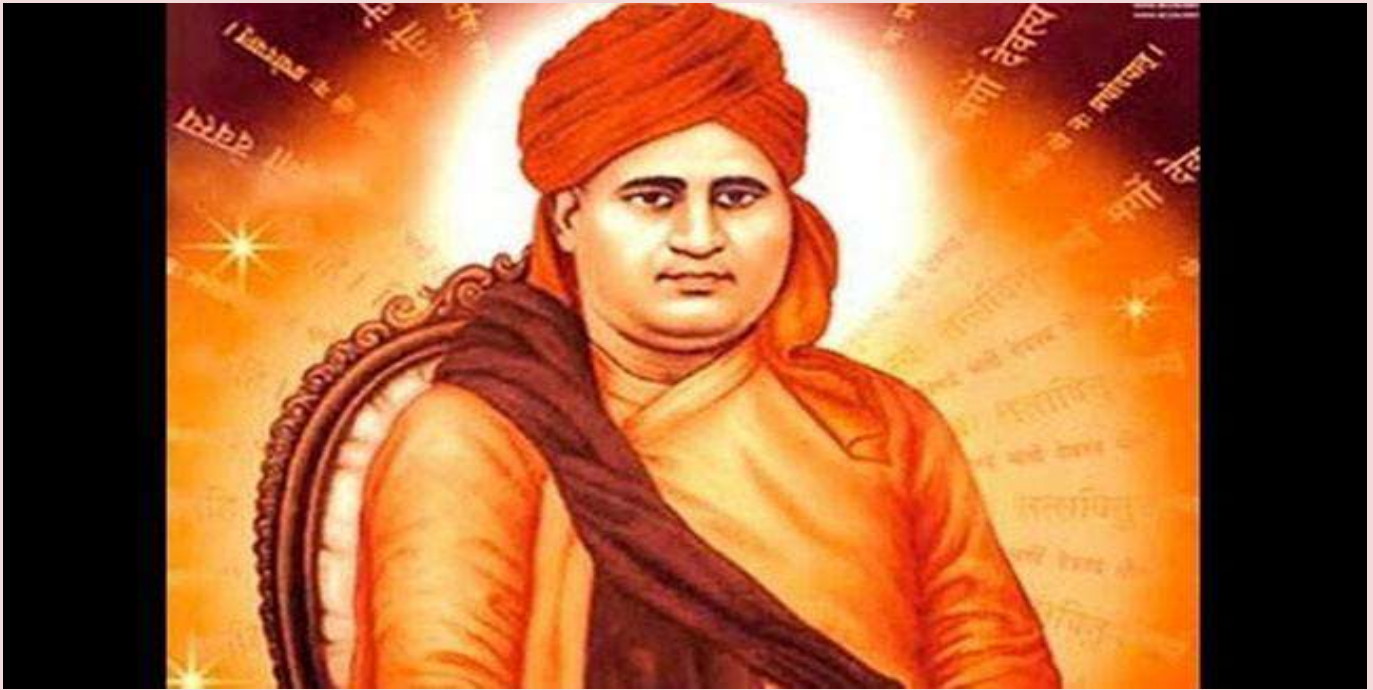
FEBRUARY EVENTS

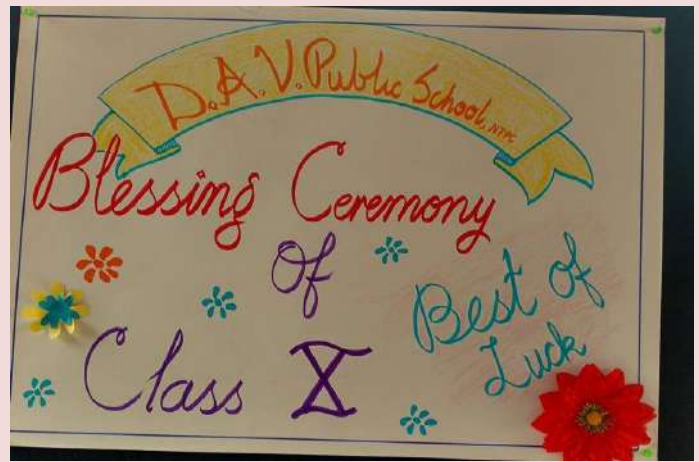

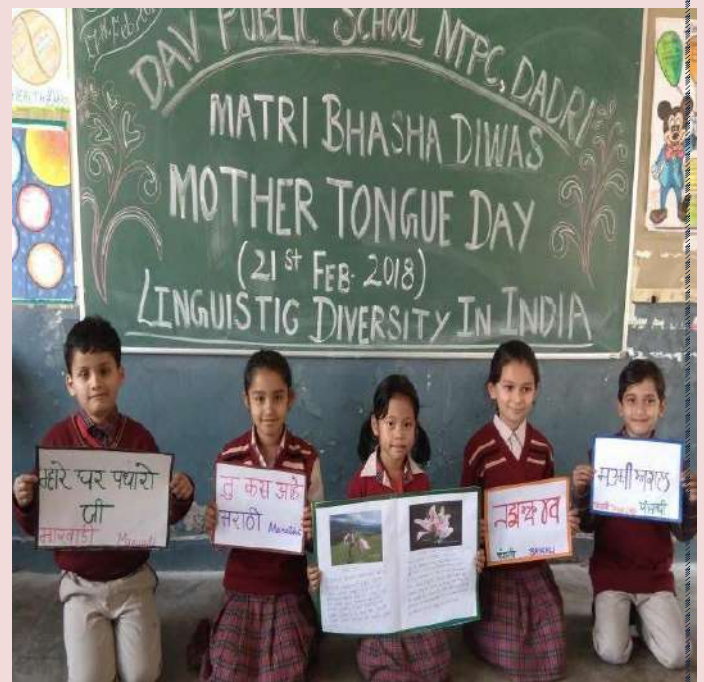
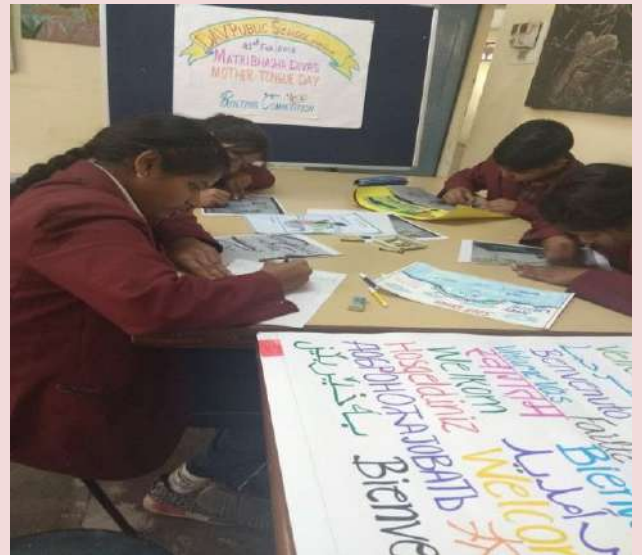
BLESSING CEREMONY OF **CLASS XII**
